**COURT DISMISSES CRAIG WIRELESS MOTION FOR INJUNCTION
AGAINST LOOK AND UBS**

Craig also withdraws challenge to CRTC approval of Look ownership change

TORONTO and MONTREAL, May 4, 2004 – Look Communications Inc. (TSX Venture: LOK) and Unique Broadband Systems, Inc. (TSX Venture: UBS) today announced that they have obtained an order from the Ontario Superior Court of Justice dismissing the motion brought by Craig Wireless International Inc. for, among other things, an interim injunction which would prevent UBS from voting its shares of Look and converting into common shares the debentures issued to UBS pursuant to Look's recent rights offering. Craig Wireless consented to the dismissal.

Craig Wireless has also agreed to a dismissal of its appeal to the Federal Court of Appeal of the October 2003 decision of the CRTC, which approved Look's application to permit UBS to acquire a controlling interest in Look.

UBS is a publicly listed Canadian company that has investments in a technology company, licensed spectrum and a 51% economic interest in Look Communications Inc. With its licensed spectrum through its affiliate, Look Communications, UBS is a Canadian digital television broadcaster and broadband wireless service provider.
